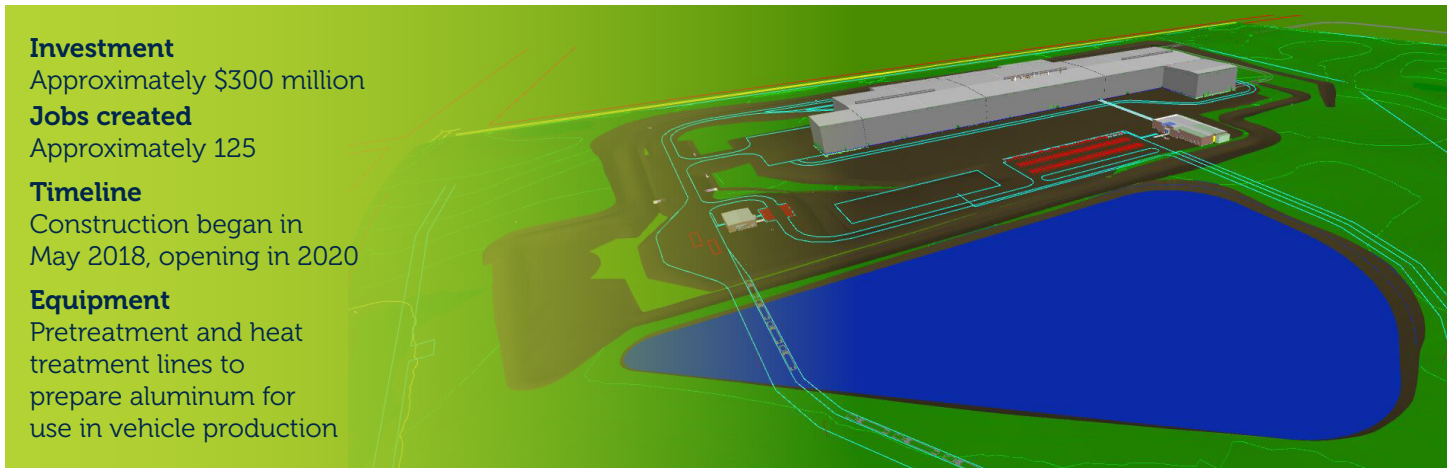


# Novelis Facility in Guthrie, Kentucky

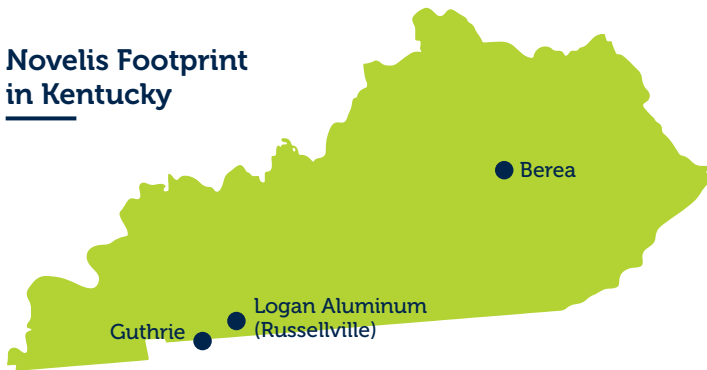
## Timeline

## Novelis Footprint in Kentucky



- Novelis has been making aluminum in Kentucky for 34 years. With the addition of its new Guthrie facility, Novelis will expand its operations in Kentucky from two to three locations.

### – Logan Aluminum, Inc.:

- Opened in 1983, jointly owned by Novelis and Tri-Arrows Aluminum
- Fully integrated rolled aluminum facility serving the beverage can, automotive and specialty markets

### – Berea:

- Opened in 1989
- Recycling facility melts down used beverage cans to produce aluminum for new cans

### – Guthrie:

- Slated to open in 2020
- Automotive aluminum finishing plant preparing aluminum for use in vehicle parts such as body-in-white, hoods, doors, lift gates and fenders
